- 3.) Commander(s) Check the Schedule for Allotted Set-Up and Clean-Up Times
- 4.) Activities need to be “Ready” for when the First Patrol/Outpost Arrives
- 5.) Please - Stay the Full-Allotted Time(s) for Your Activity - So All can have a Chance to Compete
- 6.) Be “Ready” with a “Tiebreaker” if a Tie Occurs
- 7.) Please Double Check and Fill-Out the Proper Paperwork for Winning Patrol(s) and/or Boy(s)

- 2.) Winner(s) are Determined by either Time(s) or Score(s)
 - A.) This is Up to the Section/Commander(s) Running the Activity
 - B.) **Commander(s) have a Tiebreaker Ready in Case of Tie(s)**
- 3.) Scores Determined by the Patrols’ Knowledge and Skill(s)
- 4.) Patrols Cannot Compete if the Activity is Full - So Move to Another Activity so Your Boys are Not Standing Around
- 5.) Medals Awarded for First (1st), Second (2nd), & Third (3rd) Place(s) for All Age Groups
- 6.) First (1st), Second (2nd), & Third (3rd) Place Medals for Overall Event Winners

Take I-195 **West (W)** to New Jersey Turnpike **South (S)**
Take **Exit #7** from the New Jersey Turnpike to Route 206 **South (S)**
Proceed on 206 **South (S)** for **Twelve (12) Miles** and **Merge Right (R)** onto Main Street
Proceed **1.1 Miles** and **Turn Right (R)** onto Mills Street
Mills Street **Turns** into Church Road after **.3 miles**
Continue on Church Road for **3.7 miles**
Crossroads Assembly is on the **Right (R)**

From North New Jersey:

Take **Exit #7** from the New Jersey Turnpike to Route 206 **South (S)**



- Will be a Timed Activity with a Fifteen (15) Minute Time Limit
 - Patrol is Four (4) Boys
 - "Make a Blanket Stretcher"
 - Perform "First-Aid" for a Broken Arm by "Splinting the Forearm", "Slinging the Arm", and "Carrying the Victim Through a Set Course"
 - Patrol with the Best Time Wins
- Patrons:**
- A Patrol will be Considered at the Age Group with the Most or Oldest Boys
 - A Patrol is four (4) boys
 - Examples: One (1) Adventure Ranger and three (3) Discovery Rangers is a Discovery Patrol



“Blanket Stretcher”



This Technique Requires Two (2) Poles and One (1) Blanket:

- 1.) Place the Blanket on the Ground
- 2.) Place One (1) Pole Approximately One-Foot (1') from the Middle of the Blanket
- 3.) Fold the Short End of the Blanket over the First (1st) Pole
- 4.) Place the Second (2nd) Pole Approximately Two-Feet (2') from the First (1st) -
This Distance May Vary with Victim or Blanket Size
- 5.) Fold Both Halves of the Blanket over the Second (2nd) Pole

- Object:** - Build the tallest tower with the blocks provided
- Activity:** - Will be a Timed Patrol Activity with a Fifteen (15) Minute Time Limit
- Each Boy Removes a Block of Wood and Build the Tower Higher
- Boys will Need to have Steady Hands
- Patrons:** - A Patrol will be Consider at the Age Group with the Most or Oldest Boys
- Patrol is Four (4) Boys
- Examples: One (1) Adventure Ranger and Three (3) Discovery Rangers is a Discovery Patrol
Two (2) Adventure Rangers and two (2) Expedition Rangers is a Expedition Patrol


- Rules:** - Time will Start When Boy(s) are Ready
- Boy will Remove One (1) Block and Place on Top of the Tower to Make it Taller
- Boys Can Use a Ladder to Complete the Stack as Needed
- Time will End after Removing All Possible Pieces, the Stack Falls Over, or Time Runs Out
- Patrol with the Highest Tower Wins
- Boys will Take Down the Stack and Restack Blocks for the Next Patrol
- Tie breaker - Boys will have Two (2) Minutes to Build the Tallest Tower

- Staff:** - Two (2) Commanders
- Setup for Two (2) Stations



 - Boys will Lash a "Fishing Pole" Together Using Two (2) "**Sheer Lashing**" per Splice - Four (4) Total
 - Attach Nut to String
 - Attach String to the "Fishing Pole"
 - Spring Mouse Trap so it Attaches to String and Nut and Retrieve to Other Side
 - Ten (10) Second Penalty Added for Each Incorrect Lashing Knots
 - Patrol with the Best Time Wins

"FISHING"



"SHEER LASHING"

Is used to join two (2) parallel sticks/poles together


Start with a Clove Hitch on one (1) stick/pole

Place the other stick/pole parallel and make four (4) to six (6) parallel Winds until the sticks/poles are bound firmly

Frap by pulling twine between sticks/poles

Make three (3) or four (4) Winds and pull each Wind until tight

End with a Square Knot



Can use any knot(s) to secure twine to the end of the stick/pole and nut to the end of the twine

NO FIRE MATERIALS SUPPLIED - OUTPOSTS MUST GATHER OR BRING THEIR OWN **ONLY THE EQUIPMENT LISTED BELOW WILL BE AVAILABLE**

Object: - Build an "A"-Frame and/or Structure Fire(s) - Hunter Fire is Suggested
- Cook a pancake which the Commander will eat

Activity: - Is a timed activity with a fifteen (15) minute time limit
- Patrol is four (4) Boys

Patrons: - A Patrol will be considered at the Age Group with the most or oldest boys

Examples: One (1) Adventure Ranger and three (3) Discovery Rangers is a Discovery Patrol
Two (2) Adventure Rangers and two (2) Expedition Rangers is an Expedition Patrol

Rules: - Boys will "Build a Teepee or Structure Fire"
- Fire should be "Build in Such a Fashion" to cook a pancake

- Time will stop when the "Pancakes is cooked & eaten" or "Time Runs Out"
- Put fire put "According to the "A. I. C." Handbook" - "Sprinkle, Stir, Sprinkle"
- Clean-Up and remove all materials to designated area
- Patrol with the best time wins
- A Thirty (30) Second Penalty Will be Added for "Not Cleaning Up Your Area"

Option: Fire can be "Lit by Using Cotton Ball and Metal Match"

- Setup Multiple Stations
- Setup time from 8:30 to 9:15 AM } Adjust as needed
