

I am asking all the Sectional FCF Reps and Commanders to get the word out to their Section that the applications must be reviewed for completeness by the Sectional FCF Rep prior to sending them to me. All new member applications are due to me with a twenty-five (\$25.00) dollar deposit no later than March 31<sup>st</sup>. Make checks payable to NJMN and put FCF in the memo line. After they are reviewed and accepted, I will send a letter which they "MUST" read very carefully. The remaining twenty-five (\$25.00) will be due at the Trace. ### From The New Jersey Turnpike

Take the US-206 exit, EXIT 7, toward Bordentown/Trenton. Turn **Left** (L) onto US-30 - South White Horse Pike. Turn slight **Right** (R) onto Weymouth Rd/CR-640. Continue to follow Weymouth Rd/CR-640, after a couple of miles it turns into Rt. 559 South. After you go over the AC Expressway overpass, about a half (1/2) mile, you will make a **Left** (L) onto Creek Road (Gravel), turn **Right** (R) after a one and a half (1.5) miles - Camp is on the **Right**.

#### From the Garden State Parkway Heading South

Short Cut: (For Skip and John)

Get off at the Galloway Service Plaza. As soon as you enter the plaza you can make a quick Left (L), then another Left (L) to exit the Parkway. Go to the "T" and turn Left (L) onto Jimmie Leeds Road. Follow Jimmie Leeds Road to Route 30. Take 30 West, when you see DiDonato's Bowling Alley on the Right, Turn slight left (L) onto Moss Mill Road - CR-561 then take the 1st Left onto Weymouth Road - CR-640. Continue to follow Weymouth Road, after you go over the AC Expressway overpass, about a half-mile, you will make a Left (L) on Creek Road (Gravel), turn Right (R) after a one and a half (1.5) miles - Camp is on the Right.

#### From Northeast NJ - Sure Thing

Take the Parkway **South** to the Atlantic City Expressway going West. Take **Exit 12** off the Expressway. After the toll, turn **Left (L)**, then **Right (R)** onto Route 322 West. Stay on Route 322 West to CR-559 **North**. Right after the bridge bear L**eft** to stay on CR-559. About three (3) or so miles, make a **Right (R)** onto Creek Road (Gravel). Turn **Right (R)** after a one and a half (1.5) miles - Camp is on the **Right**.

#### From the Garden State Parkway Heading North from Cape May Area

Take the Garden State Parkway to Atlantic City Expressway West. Take **Exit 12** off the Expressway. After the toll, turn **Left (L)**, then **Right (R)** onto Route 322 West. Stay on Route 322 West to CR-559 **North**. Right after the bridge bear L**eft** to stay on CR-559. About three (3) or so miles, make a **Right (R)** onto Creek Road (Gravel). Turn **Right (R)** after a one and a half (1.5) miles - Camp is on the **Right**.

#### From Southwest NJ


Take the Atlantic City Expressway to Exit 28. After the toll, make a **Left (L)**, go to the first traffic light and make a **Right (R)** onto "**2nd Road**". Three (3) miles down - turn **Right (R)** onto Route 559 South. After you go over the Atlantic City Expressway overpass, about a half (1/2) mile, you will make a **Left (L)** onto Creek Road (Gravel) after one and a half (1.5) miles - Camp is on the **Right**.

#### From Southern Section

Pick-up Route 54 North in Buena. Right after the Atlantic City Expressway ramp, make a **Right (R)** at the first light onto "**2nd Road**". Three (3) miles down - turn **Right (R)** onto Route 559 South. After you go over the Atlantic City Expressway overpass, about a half (1/2) mile, you will make a **Left (L)** onto Creek Road (Gravel) after one and a half (1.5) miles - Camp is on the **Right**.
